After some review and discussion, on a motion by Mr. Bucuren; seconded by Mr. Sylvester to award the Base Bid, Alternate 1 and Alternate 2 Bids for the 2022 Road Improvement Project to Youngblood Paving, Inc. in the amount of \$ 602,184.85. Motion was unanimously approved.

C. Sunset Drive Drainage Improvement Project -

After some review and discussion, on a motion by Mr. Ruckert; seconded by Mr. Metz to authorize the Borough Manager to advertise for bids for the Sunset Drive drainage improvement project. Motion was unanimously approved.

D. Underground Storage Tank (Diesel) -

After some review and discussion, on a motion by Mr. Sivy; seconded by Mr. Ruckert to approve the proposal from Keystone Petroleum Equipment LTD., in the amount of \$11,800.00, for the removal of the underground storage tank for diesel, located at the Public Works building.
